Despite all the pandemic upheavals, with your help, we managed to increase the number of people enjoying our concerts! Our new mix of live and virtual offerings was well received, and your generous support made it all possible; you gave us hope.

The Gallery Players of Niagara is delighted to announce a season of **Live** concerts for 2021-2022. Building on the successes of last season, all these concerts, except our Movie Night, will be video-recorded and made available virtually. Of course, we are still living with Covid-19; future restrictions may derail some plans. If that happens, we'll adjust! We became very flexible, working hard to offer great music in every single concert slot throughout last season's constraints. If need be, we'll do it again.

This season we're offering 7 Live in-person concerts, and 8 virtual concerts (6 recordings of our live concerts + 2 prerecorded concerts). Through a generous grant, four of our virtual concerts will be offered at no charge. We heard from many of you last season that the Gallery Players' virtual concerts are a great way to introduce us to your friends. They also make a unique Christmas gift, and digital concerts can be enjoyed from anywhere in the world, so please take advantage of these one-time free concerts and share the Gallery Players with your friends!

This options on this year's ticket order form look more similar to our pre-Covid selections than our 2020-21 Ticket Pledge. We have streamlined your choices to three distinct types of subscriptions; *All 7 Live, Pick 4 Live,* and *Virtual Only.* As well, single tickets will be available. <u>New this season</u> – Virtual concerts will be available from the date they're first presented until July 31, 2022. You'll be able to listen to our performances at your convenience, as often as you choose!

Four For Free - 4 subsidized virtual concerts

The four, free virtual concerts are made possible by a significant grant. This one-time funding will enable the Gallery Players of Niagara to produce a digital concert series and distribute it free of charge to Long Term Care Facilities and Retirement Homes across Niagara. In addition to offering this series to our patrons, the Gallery Players of Niagara has also used this opportunity as a springboard for an exciting partnership with the St. Catharines Public Library, bringing classical music concerts to a new audience through their network.

A few concert-going notes

Masks will be required for patrons at all indoor presentations this season.

The safety of our patrons, musicians, volunteers and staff is our top priority. After consultation with our arts industry partners, public health experts, our performers, venues, and volunteers, we will require proof* of full vaccination or a recent negative COVID-19 test result for anyone aged 12 and older attending or performing our concerts. Our commitment to you: all Gallery Players' performers, staff, and volunteers in the 2021-2022 season are fully vaccinated.

*vaccine receipt, official test result, or any forthcoming government-issued document | exemptions accepted for medical reasons.

We will also faithfully adhere to any additional policies the venues may choose to impose in the future, including (but not limited to) lower capacity limits.

All concerts at Silver Spire will include physical distancing measures.

Concerts at the FirstOntario Performing Arts Centre may be permitted at 50% occupancy. This does not quite allow for full physical distancing; however, rows will be staggard and a minimum of 3 seats between each group of people will help to ensure your safety.

Digital concert information, including detailed programme notes, will be distributed prior to each performance.

If available, tickets will be sold at the venue on the day of concerts, as well as on our website. Depending upon capacity restrictions on the day, we cannot guarantee available seats. Please call or email to confirm (905-468-1525) or info@galleryplayers.ca

If a concert is cancelled, the ticket will be eligible to exchange for a future concert, a tax receipt, or a refund.
